


Plastic shopping bags CAN be recycled at the grocery store or at Southern Recycling, but not in the City's blue bin.



Dryer sheet ... CANNOT be recycled, although you might try composting it.



Thin scrap metal CAN be recycled at Southern Recycling ... if it's clean.



Plastic bottles #1 or #2 CAN be recycled. Put them in the BLUE bin or bring to Southern Recycling.




Solo cups CANNOT be recycled in Carbondale. But maybe some day.



Plastic wrappers ... this one looks contaminated with food. Let's TRASH it.



Cigarette boxes contain cardboard, plus plastic on the outside and foil on the inside. But maybe some day soon ... Sort it all out or just TRASH it.



A shredded clear plastic cup ... TRASH.



Clear plastic drink lid. Can you see the #? It looks like a #6. TRASH But maybe some day soon ...



Rubber gloves ... pretty dirty. TRASH. Let's not add that to the recycling stream.



Aluminum foil can be recycled at Southern Recycling ... if it's clean. But it probably isn't. TRASH it.



Aerosol cans CAN be recycled with other metals at Southern Recycling IF they are empty.



Glass bottles CAN be recycled. Remove lid, rinse out, and place in the BLUE bin, or bring to drop-off or Southern Recycling.



Aluminum cans CAN be recycled. Rinse them out and put them in the BLUE bin.



Plastic bottles CAN be recycled. Remove lid and place in the BLUE bin, or bring to drop-off or Southern Recycling.



Cardboard CAN be recycled, esp. clean (no food contaminating the resource). Place in the GREEN bin with other paper.
